

1) Class Meeting Times:

- A) Drivers Education is a quarter long course.
- B) Drivers Education meets daily at 7:05am until 7:50am (0 Period).

2) Attendance & Grading:

- A) Students will be allowed 3 excused absences. For every absence after that a student will owe 1 day of attendance during the next quarter before they will be given their completion certificate.
- B) For every 2 times a student is late to class an absence will be given. Students will be allowed up to 6 tardies. For every 2 tardies after that a student will owe 1 day of attendance during the next quarter before they will be given their completion certificate.
- C) A combination of absences and tardies will be counted based on A & B above.
- D) Students who miss 6 or more days with combined tardies and absences will be dropped from the course.
- E) Grades will be based on attendance, participation, and successful completing of class assignments.

3) Course Structure:

- A) Students will study the **California Drivers Handbook** and complete assignments that revolve around the content covered in the handbook.
- B) Students will learn the procedures and requirements for receiving a Minors' Permit.
- C) Students will view videos surrounding different driving topics.
- D) Students will use a computer to practice applying the rules of the road.
- E) Students will view web pages and complete assignments to support information provided in the **California Drivers Handbook**.
- F) Students will be exposed to guest speakers who will address issues pertaining to new drivers.

4) Classroom Standards:

- A) Be friendly and respectful towards others.
- B) Do not disrupt other student's ability to learn.
- C) Use appropriate language in the classroom.
- D) Be cooperative towards the teacher and others in the classroom.
- E) Treat equipment, materials, and the classroom with extreme care.
- F) Check "Assignment List" for absent work.

5) Advice to the Student:

- A) It is recommended that students continually study the **California Drivers Handbook** on their personal time.
- B) The longer a student waits to take the Provisional Permit Test the more the information will fade in your mind.
- C) Upon successful completion of this course students may take the Provisional Permit Test weekly until they pass. If you do not pass, study areas you struggled with and retake the test.
